1. What did you find most helpful / encouraging?
2. What did you find most difficult / challenging?
3. Who are you connected to? Who are the (Christian) people that it is important that you are connected to? Why? How does it make you feel when you don't get to spend time with them?
4. How do you ensure you remain connected to the people that matter?
5. How do you routinely remain connected with God?
6. Keith often talks about how sin separates us from connection with God and others. Can you see how that may be so? Explain.
7. Reflect upon the things that are separating you from God and others? (Not to be shared, unless you feel it will of benefit to the group)
8. Keith spoke about how remaining connected helps us grow as followers of Jesus? Can you see how that may be so? Has that been your experience? If so, please share.
9. Who are you connected to today who are helping you grow as a follower of Jesus? (No need to share, but you can.)
10. Who are you connected with today who you are helping to grow as a follower of Jesus? (No need to share.)
11. Give thanks for those people you have listed in 3, 8, 9 and 10.
12. There is much in the Romans reading that Keith did not elaborate on that you may want to discuss/question. Please do so.
