Guidance notes

Morning prayer uses a structure (liturgy) to help guide our prayers. However, our time together is relaxed and informal. A host will guide us through the liturgy but it is designed to be interactive with opportunities for all to pray.

- Please feel able to turn your microphone and video off if you'd like. E.g. if you have a busy morning, you are welcome to simply listen as you get on with the tasks of the day.
- If you are new, please introduce yourself and use your name as an identifier so we know who is joining us.
